Staff Changes

After half term there will be several changes to the staffing arrangements in school which you need to be aware of. Firstly, it is with much sadness that I have to inform you that Mrs Crabbe will be leaving us and Year 6 in particular, due to on-going health problems, following cancer. Mrs Crabbe has worked at our school for 12 years and in this time has worked exceptionally hard to ensure that all the children in her care have achieved to the very best of their ability. The children in Year 6 have always made outstanding progress as a result of her teaching and, just as importantly, been helped to develop and mature in readiness for the transition to senior school. In more recent years, she has been an extremely valued member of the senior leadership team, working with myself, Mrs Beach and the governors to bring about many improvements to teaching and learning throughout the school. She will be greatly missed but we wish her every happiness and a return to good health in the future.

Her Year 6 teaching role will be covered temporarily by Miss Jenny Corbett, who is currently covering Mrs Marshall's maternity leave.

In Year 5, Mrs Kaighan will be starting her maternity leave and obviously we wish her well and will be waiting excitedly to meet little baby Kaighan! The class will be taught by Miss Bridget Penellum until we finish in July.

Finally, in Year 4, Mrs Jesson will be reducing her teaching commitment. In order to ensure continuity and stability for the children, we have temporarily employed another teacher, Mrs Lorna Thompson, who will be able to work full-time in the class. We warmly welcome our new staff and I know they will soon settle in and you will get to know them.
