### Ice Pole Sale

For the rest of the term we will be selling ice -poles every afternoon break for 20p. All proceeds will go towards the Bluebell Foundation which is a local charity who offer free support for children who are grieving through the death or anticipated death of someone important to them. They try to enable families to begin to understand their grief and cope with their loss. Several children and families in our school have benefited from this valuable service.

### 30 hours Nursery funding

For working families With 3 and 4-year-old children you may be eligible for an extra 15 hours a week of free childcare - so 30 in all. You, and any partner, must each expect to earn (on average) at least £120 a week (equal to 16 hours at the National Minimum or Living Wage). If you, or your partner, are on maternity, paternity or adoption leave, or you're unable to work because you are disabled or have caring responsibilities, you could still be eligible.
