After School Club

Because of increasing number we have now moved after school club to Sacred Heart presbytery so that the children have more space to play. This is accessed through the gate in the nursery playground when you come to collect your child. The telephone number to contact After School Club between 3.30pm and 5.30pm is **821498**

A reminder that it is available Monday - Friday from 3.15pm - 5.30pm.

The cost, unfortunately, will be rising from Monday 11th September to £2 per hour (£4 for the full session). This is to ensure that we do not run at a loss as we currently are.

Breakfast club

This remains in class 1 and is available from 7.45am - 8.30 am and the cost for this remains the same - £1.50

New Cashless System

As from next week the school will be using a new cashless system similar to one already in place for school lunches. This means that everything (tuck shop, after school and breakfast club, lunches and nursery fees) will all be booked and paid for online. Information regarding log in details will be texted to all parents soon.

As a result of this we will now need to set a deadline for booking places so for Breakfast club the deadline for booking a place is 3.30pm the day before and for After-school club the deadline must be 12.00 noon on the day.

Nursery parents will be given details of how to pay Nursery fees at a later date. A new App which will enable parents to use this system more easily will be available soon—details to follow!
